Earning a red ribbon in the Serious Category was Lucy Baur performing "What's The Worst That Could Happen?"

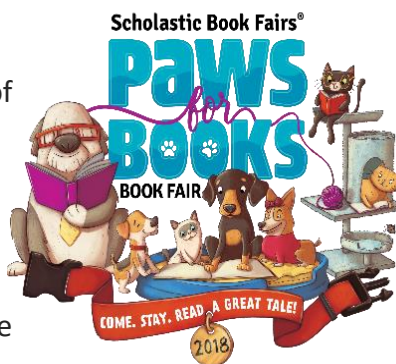
The coaches were proud of the performer's conduct and the respect they showed their fellow competitors. The extra hours of practice really reaped the rewards! Congratulations on a great year!
